The 2020 Recycling Fee is due by: January 31, 2020.

ALL patrons will use the same Key Card System where you have access to the Recycling Center with your card 24 hours a day.

or stop at the Borough Office from 8-12 or 1-4:30pm Monday thru Friday. Any questions please call 793-3213. The Area Recycling Center has been in operation for 6 years. We serve the Martinsburg Borough, North Woodbury Township and Huston Township area. We serve over 450 residents of these communities with the Recycling Center. The Recycling Center collects over 13 ton of commingled plastics, glass and cans and over 4.5 ton of cardboard and mixed paper per month.

As a reminder please consider the following:

- No Styrofoam, cloth or wood items. These CAN NOT be recycled.
- Please put all shredded papers in a paper or plastic bag before placing in the dumpster.
- Newspapers can also be placed in bags or boxes to help aid the men who pick up the items.
- Break down large boxes to save room.

WHAT CAN BE RECYCLED

Commingled Bottles and Cans

- Clear, green and brown glass bottles and jars.
- All plastic bottles and small tubs that have a number.
- Aluminum and steel cans

Cardboard and Brown Kraft Paper

- Corrugated Cardboard
- Paperboard Boxes (cereal & cracker boxes, ect.)
- Brown paper bags

Mixed Paper

- Newspaper and phone books
- Magazines and catalogs
- Paper and Junk mail
- All commingled items should be placed in the dumpsters. Please DO NOT leave Comingled items laying on the ground.
